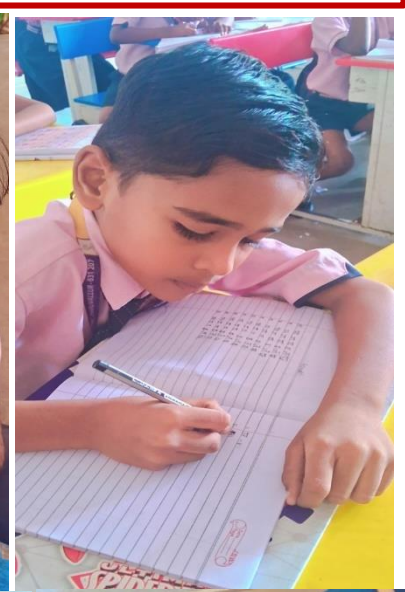
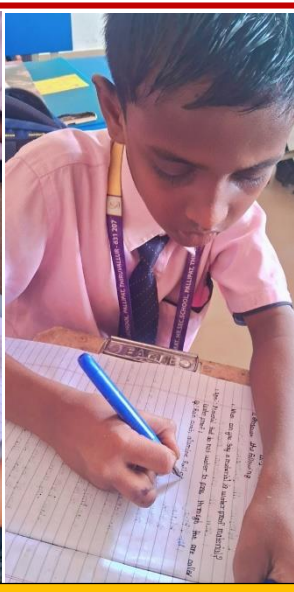
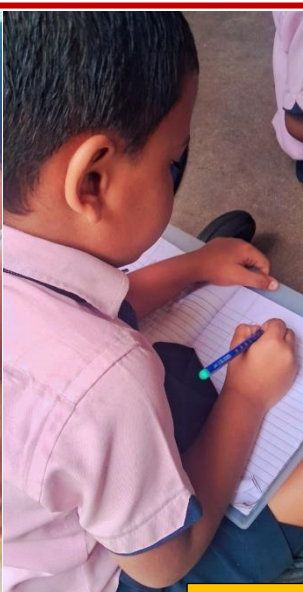
Grand Parents Day
